In 2017, I designed and instructed an 8-week training course for Grand Circus in Downtown Detroit, aimed at equipping underemployed and unemployed individuals with essential web development skills. Using technologies such as ASP.NET MVC, C#, Entity Framework, database design/programming, and agile development methodologies, this program successfully empowered participants to thrive in the tech industry. Similarly, in 2017, I partnered with Grand Circus to offer another 8-week training course in Grand Rapids, funded by the State of Michigan and local businesses.

As part of a team of 13, I was pivotal in developing a comprehensive system for 93 charter schools across nine states, facilitating the administration and tracking of all school functions. The solution, built with AngularJS 1, Bootstrap 3.0, and a REST API using C# ASP.NET Web API, MSSQL, and TFS for DevOps, demonstrated my ability to deliver robust and scalable applications.

From 2008 to 2014, I created, hosted, and produced the award-winning podcast, Deep Fried Bytes, which covered software development and technology. The podcast attracted over 50,000 downloads per episode, highlighting my ability to engage and educate a broad audience through compelling audio-visual content.
